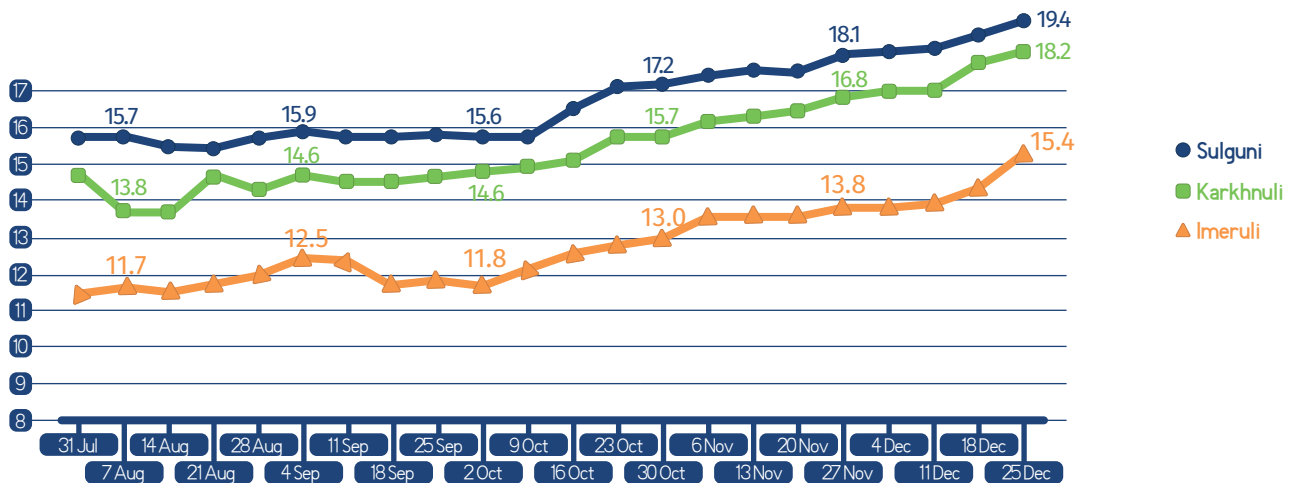


The publication reviews the dynamics of market prices of products in the livestock industry during the month of **December** 2021, across Tbilisi and the administrative centers of 10 regions in Georgia. Data collection for labeled products is performed in supermarkets, while data collection for unlabeled products is organized in agrarian markets. The prices presented in the publication are given in national currency (GEL).

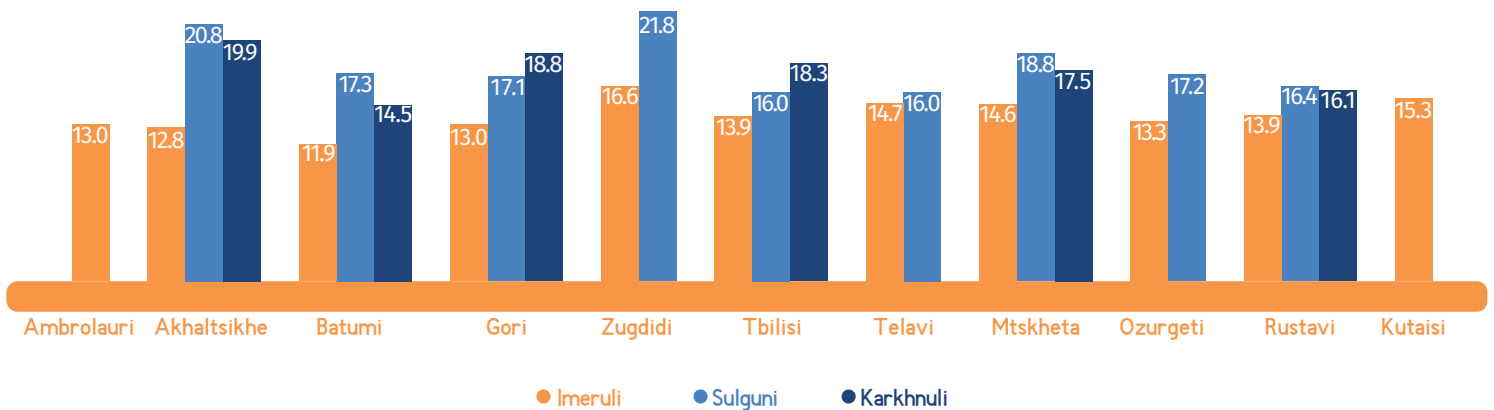


Retail price of **unlabeled cheese** has further increased in December, as expected during the winter season.

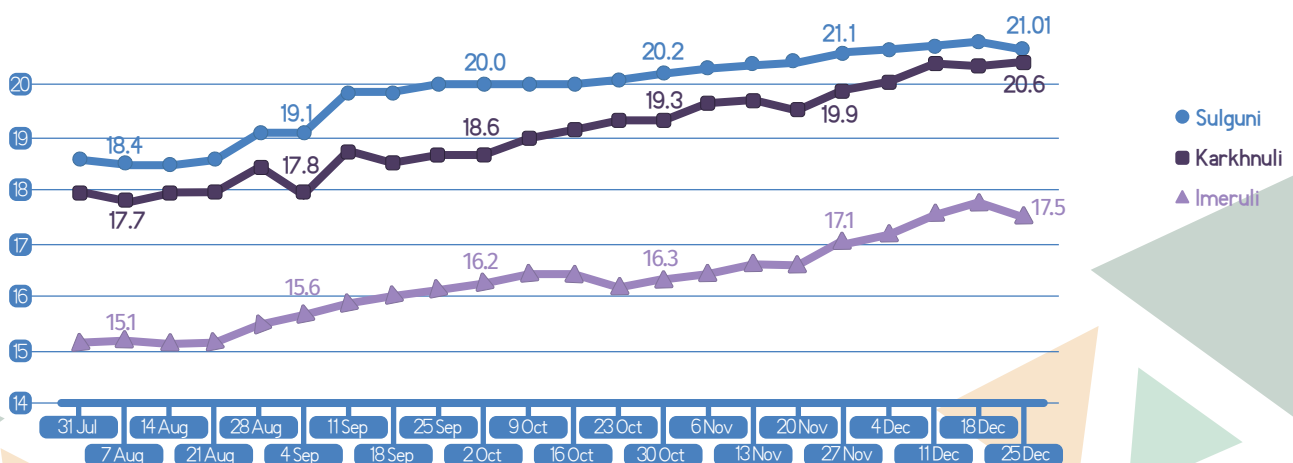

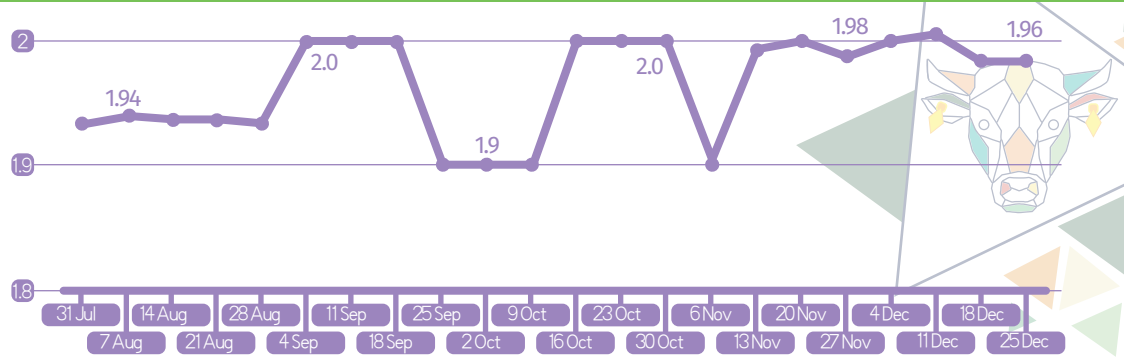
When it comes to the administrative centers Batumi, Zugdidi and Akhaltsikhe have seen the largest increase in the retail price of **unlabeled cheese**.



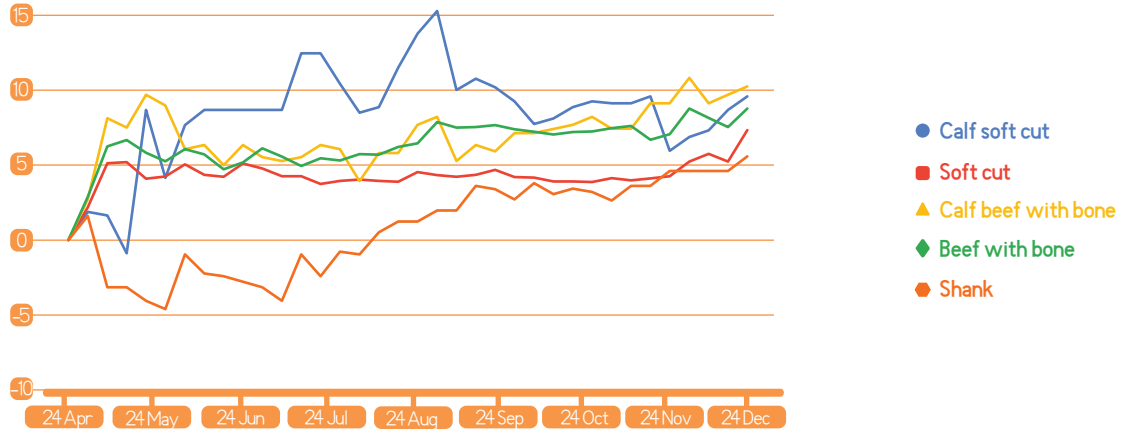
Compared to the prices of unlabeled cheese, the price of **labeled cheese** is far more rigid, mostly unaffected by the seasonal



Retail price of labeled Matsoni has stayed around GEL 2 mark.

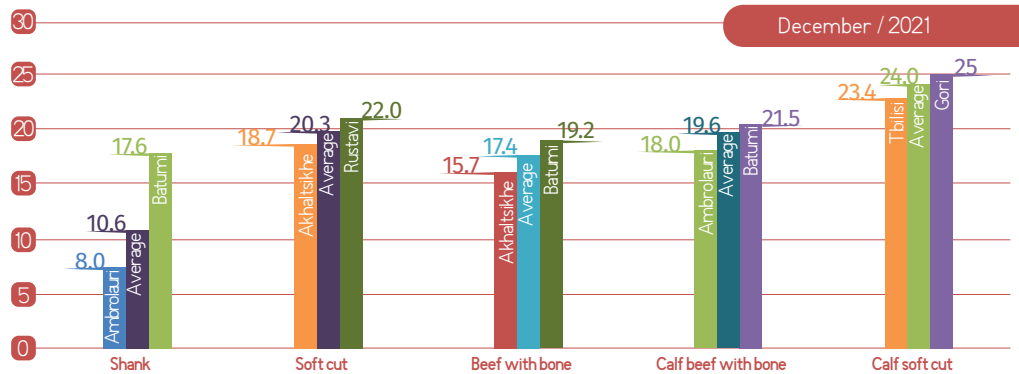


Prices of raw beef have normalized and the price percentage change has narrowed since fall, resembling an upward trend.



The lowest and highest prices of raw beef.

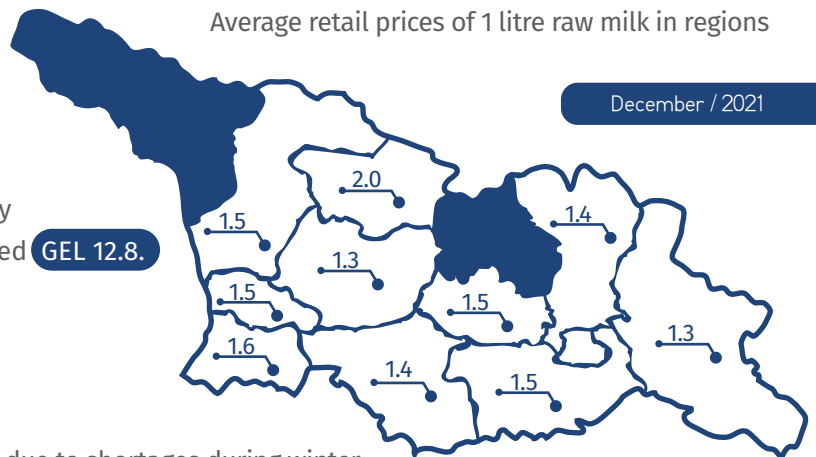
Batumi has taken the spot for one of the most expensive cities for raw beef.



Similar to the raw beef, the price of raw milk has increased the most in Adjara, surpassed only by neighboring Guria.

Average retail prices of 1 litre raw milk in regions

Unlike raw milk, the price of milk powder has actually decreased by 0.78% though insignificantly and equaled GEL 12.8.



Price change of cattle feed varies by product, mainly due to shortages during winter. However, large increase in price of hay and alfalfa hay should be noted.
