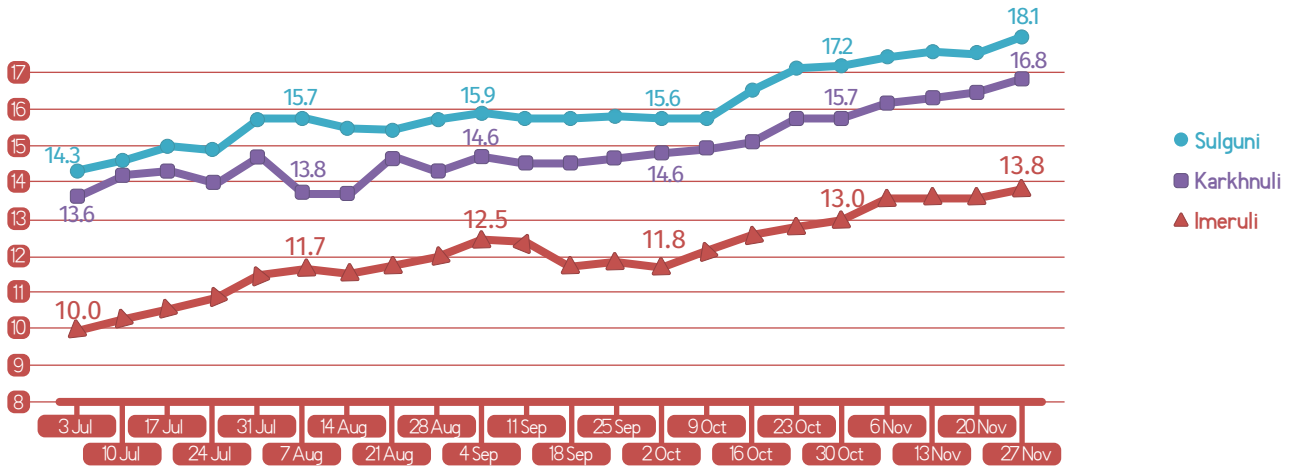


The publication reviews the dynamics of market prices of products in the livestock industry during the month of **November** 2021, across Tbilisi and the administrative centers of 10 regions in Georgia. Data collection for labeled products is performed in supermarkets, while data collection for unlabeled products is organized in agrarian markets. The prices presented in the publication are given in national currency (GEL).

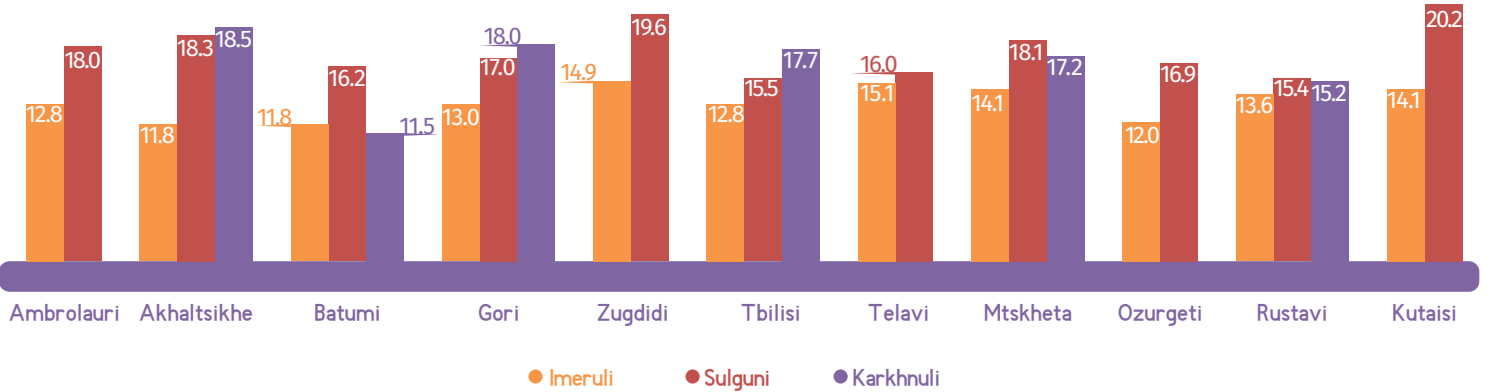


Average retail price of **unlabeled cheese** is still increasing. In November, prices of Imeruli cheese increased the most.

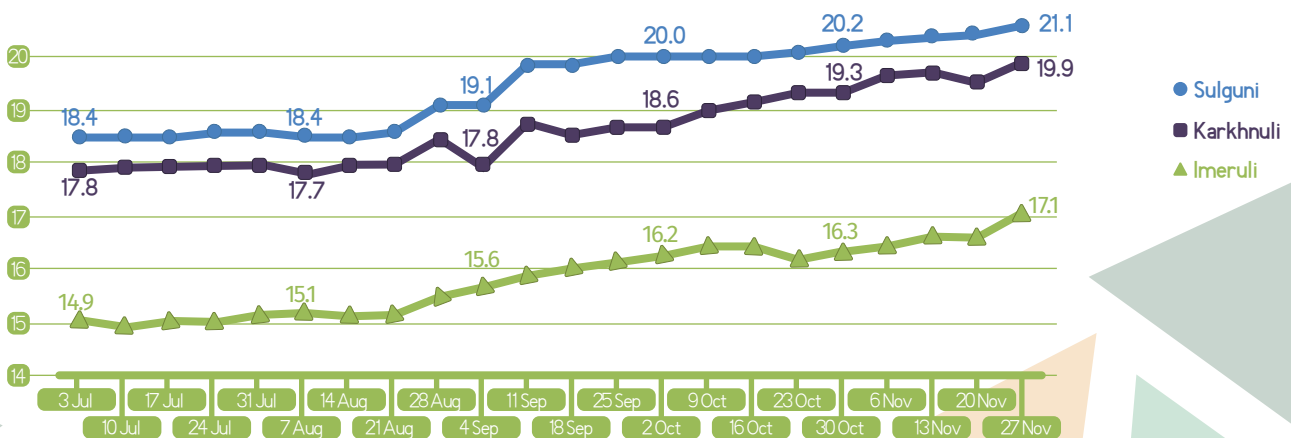

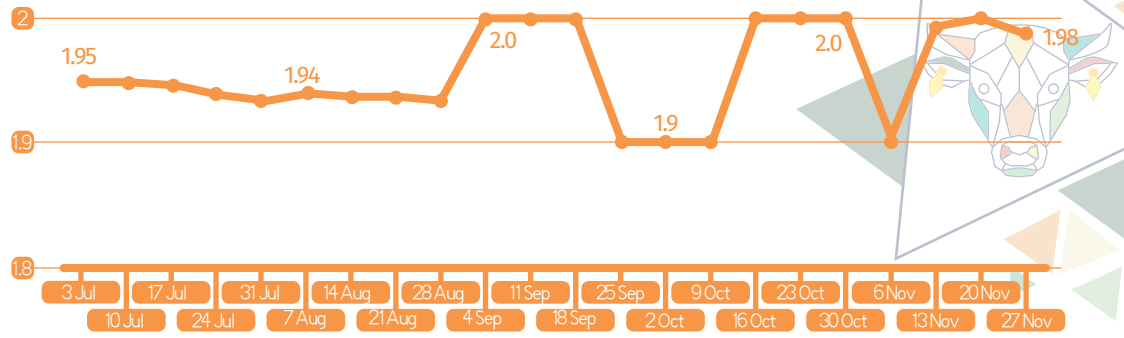

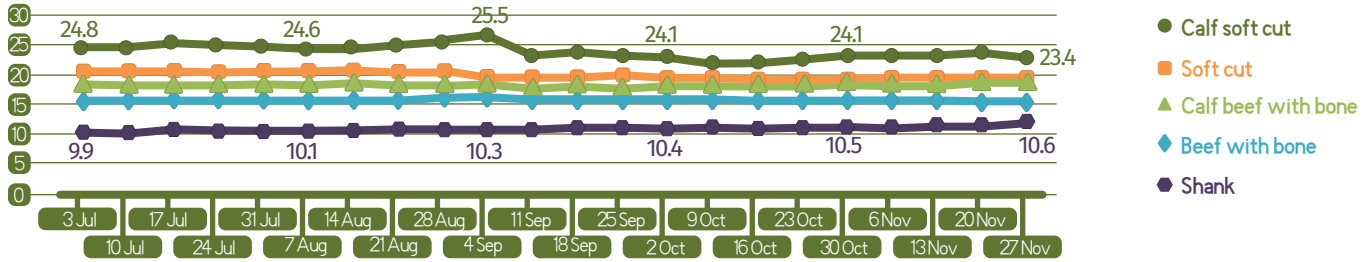
Retail price of **labeled cheese** which is produced by the same company does not change, however, the average retail price was increased in November.



Retail price of labeled Matsoni changes slightly.

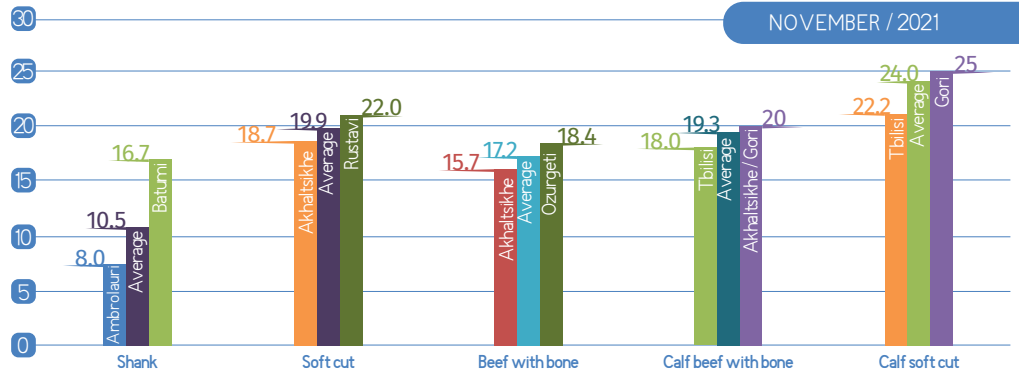


Average retail price of raw beef changed slightly in November compared to previous month.



The lowest and highest prices of raw beef.

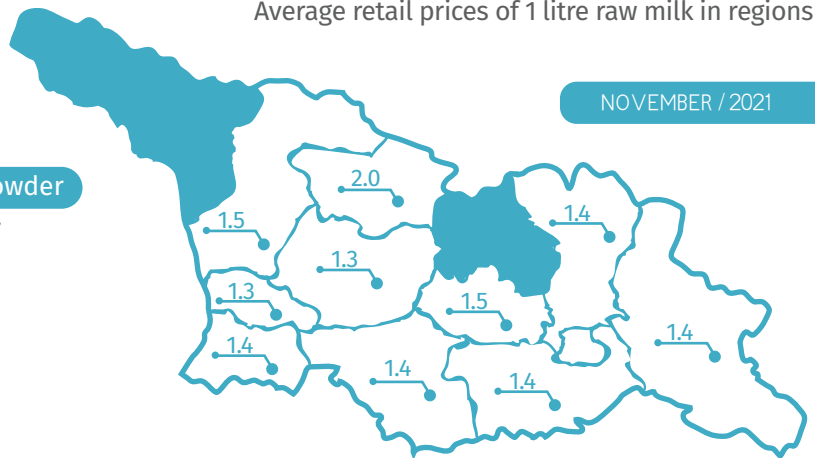
Shank and calf beef are not available in all cities.



Price of raw milk increased in almost all regions. In November compared to previous month the highest increase was observed in Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti.

Similar to the price of raw milk, the price of milk powder increased by 11.21% compared to price in October and amounted to 12.9 GEL in November.
