

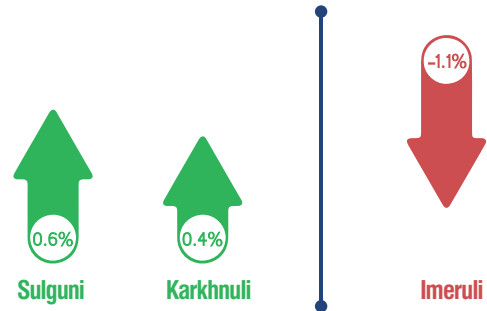


The publication reviews the dynamics of market prices of products in the livestock industry during the month of **October** 2022, across Tbilisi and the administrative centers of 10 regions in Georgia. Data collection for labeled products is performed in supermarkets, while data collection for unlabeled products is organized in agrarian markets. The prices presented in the publication are given in national currency (GEL).

October / 2022

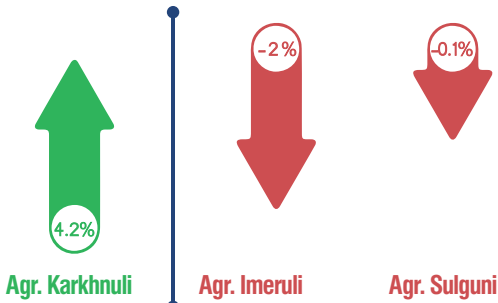
Price changes on labeled cheese products during October were insignificant, equaling **1.1% decrease for Imeruli** and less than **1% increase for Sulguni and Karkhnuli**.

Unlabeled cheese prices in the agrarian market

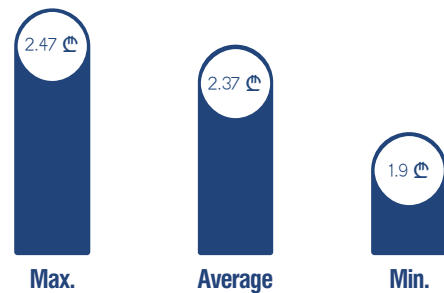


Compared to the labeled counterparts, cheese prices in **agrarian markets** were more volatile. Imeruli got **2.0%** cheaper during the month of October, while Karkhnuli price increased by **4.6%**. Meanwhile, Sulguni price decreased marginally.

October / 2022

Average price on matsoni has increased marginally in October. Notably, average prices in Rustavi have returned to sub **2 GEL** mark.

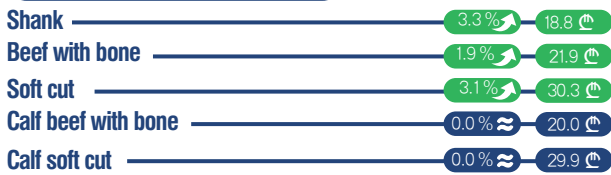
Highest, Average and Lowest price of Labeled Matsoni

Since a noticeable price surge on beef in September, prices have somewhat stabilized. Labeled beef got expensive by 2 to 3.3%, whereas unlabeled beef by 0 to 6.4%

Labeled



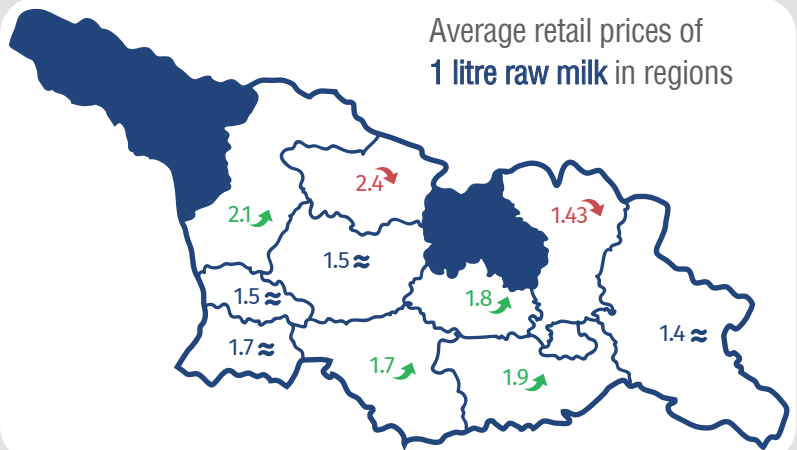

October / 2022

Price of a single liter raw milk during October got 5 tetri more expensive and equaled 1.75 GEL. Price increases were observed in Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti, Samtskhe-Javakheti, Kvemo Kartli and Shida Kartli.

Cattle feed prices were notably stable in October. With the only exceptions being barley (+5.6%), wheat (-9.5%) and sunflower meal (-16.7%)
